On behalf of the City of Snellville, I would like to extend an invitation for your organization to participate in this year's Snellville Days Parade. The annual parade kicks off the Snellville Days Festival on Saturday, May 3rd at 10 a.m. Various entries including schools, churches, civic organizations and businesses, will participate in this year's parade. There is no entry fee. Floats will be judged at 9am based on theme, originality and creativity. Cash prizes will be awarded to First Place (\$600), Second Place (\$400) and Third Place (\$200). Floats that are not present at 9am will not be eligible.

Our theme for the 35th Annual Snellville Days Festival is "A One Time Event That's Lasted 35 Years". We are encouraging all parade participants to use their entries and floats to demonstrate positive change and accomplishments over the last 35 years. This year will feature a parade route through our Town Center district. The parade will begin at the Wisteria Village Shopping Center, travel down Wisteria Drive, turn left on North Road, turn left on Oak Road, and conclude at Clower St. I have enclosed a copy of the proposed route along with the parade application.
